4. Enhancements to Existing Features

4.1 EF13: Review Java Usage

Some of the CoreBIS ETL processes use java to run some of the functions. We would like to reduce this usage, so have converted many of the calls to JAVA with standard TM1 code. While we have not managed to remove Java altogether, we have greatly reduced its use. The Validation Rules still require Java, and we have raised another card to replace that particular use case.

4.2 EF58: SQL Filesystem changes

The CoreBIS SQL Supplementary database uses stored procedure to import files from the file system. These procedures were using functions that required the user to have sysadmin rights. An alternative method has been implemented whereby these functions are not required.
