## 3. Code Updates

#### 3.1 CU69: Initial schedule of data load does no run if set for current date.

If you set the data loads to import data in the current month it did not pick up the date until the next month. This has been fixed.



#### 4. Enhancements to Existing Features

#### 4.1 EF56: Allow CoreBIS to run with 2 decimal places on all forms

Raised by TMB: APRA responded to TMB confirming that form data can be submitted in 2 decimal places even though the precision for the form is 0 decimal places.

A optional control parameter has been added to the system that allows all forms to be overwritten with a minimum decimal place, thus allowing forms with 0 decimal places to be reported as 2 decimal places, but if a form had 3 decimal places as default then it would stay as 3 decimal should you set the override to 2 decimal places.
